Better indoor climate

We spend more and more time indoors. In fact 90 per cent of the hours of the day.

A good, healthy indoor climate is vital if we are to function optimally in our daily lives. If the indoor climate is poor, there is a risk of dangerous respiratory diseases and other health problems, and in the longer term a poorer quality of life.

Many people suffer from respiratory diseases which are often caused by poor indoor ventilation.

That is why Flexit has developed healthy, energy-efficient solutions for the whole house.

Balanced ventilation is an excellent solution in which humid air is expelled from the kitchen, bathroom, toilets and laundry rooms.

In addition, fresh air at the right temperature is led into bedrooms and living rooms.

Ventilation can be increased when showers are in use and extra humidity is produced.

When humidifiers are in use, ventilation is regulated automatically.



On average, we spend 58 years of our lives at home, and as much as 27 years in the bedroom, so the air in housing is important.

Balanced ventilation with heat recovery

Balanced ventilation ensures a good indoor climate in all rooms, all year round. The house is supplied with clean, fresh air at the right temperature, and used indoor air is removed. The indoor air is kept fresh and clean, and comfort is high. You save energy, since up to 85% of the heat in the ventilation air is recovered.

Heat recovery means that the fresh air has the right temperature, and there are no cold draughts during the cold seasons. Flexit has attached great importance to developing units that can withstand the tough demands of our Scandinavian climate. The units are constructed to avoid cold bridges, and to reduce heat loss as much as possible. This means good heat recovery and minimises the risk of condensation.

Think of ventilation refurbishing

When older housing is refurbished, energy-saving steps are often taken, such as replacing windows, increasing insulation and replacing heat sources. Many people forget ventilation when housing is refurbished, and discover problems afterwards with stuffiness, condensation on windows and damage from humidity. Remember, therefore, to check what is needed to upgrade the ventilation before you begin refurbishing – not afterwards.



Advantages of balanced ventilation

- Polluted and humid indoor air is removed
- The home is supplied with clean, filtered air at the right temperature
- High comfort, low noise and draught-free ventilation
- Saves energy and recovers up to 85% of the heat in the ventilated air
- Developed for demanding climates, so it functions optimally, even during the cold seasons



Food ventilation is even more important in new homes

Newly built houses are airtight and well insulated to save energy and prevent heat loss. At the same time, building regulations require energy-efficient ventilation in the home. The intention is to create an energy-efficient building with a good indoor climate. Energy-efficient ventilation solutions are needed, which provide fresh, clean air, removing spent and polluted air and recovering the heat.

The Nordic series are the best air handling units on the market for a cold climate. They provide balanced ventilation and supply the house with clean, filtered fresh air at the right temperature. The unit is easily controlled from an app from a smart phone or tablet, or with an ordinary control panel.

The air handling unit in the Nordic series has been developed to be energy efficient in the Scandinavian climate. It fits well in apartments, small buildings, bungalows and small commercial properties, and helps to produce a very good indoor climate. A rangehood can easily be connected using a bypass solution. The air handling unit has highly efficient rotating heat exchangers with temperature efficiency levels up to 85%, and fans with low energy requirements.

All Nordic units have the Flexit GO app as the default control, and can be supplemented with a variety of accessories, either wireless or cable-connected, e.g. a control panel, humidifier, pressure sensor for a rangehood, CO2 sensor etc. The control system is prepared for control according to local requirements. When extract-air humidity is high, the defrosting function secures operation in a cold climate.

All air handling units in the Nordic series can by default be controlled via BACnet IP och Modbus RTU*.

*Modbus RTU cannot be used for Nordic KS3



Energy-efficient and smart ventilation for a better indoor climate

Energy efficient

Air handling units in the Nordic series are highly energy efficient. The fan motors in the units do not need much energy to transport the air. The rotating heat exchanger in the air handling unit recovers a high proportion of the heat. The unit provides the owner with optimal in the home, at the lowest possible energy costs.

Cooling recovery and night cooling in summer

On hot summer days the outdoor temperature rises rapidly, which means that in some periods it is cooler indoors because of thermal inertia. During these periods, the supply air is cooled by the cooler extract air. Cooling recovery is a standard function. At night, when the outdoor air is cooler than the indoor air, the cooler outdoor air cools the house – i.e. there is summer night cooling. This function can be activated in the Flexit GO app as required.



Built-in humidity control in the Nordic series

The air handling unit has an integrated humidity sensor that measures the average humidity level of all extract air points in the home. Usually, you would have fixed limit values, but Flexit has chosen to use minor and rapid changes to activate the dehumidification function.

Built-in humidity control provides the following benefits

- There are no absolute limits to set.
- The function is season-independent with regard to varying humidity levels.
- When you don't need to set absolute humidity levels, this reduces the risk of false or non-activation due to varying humidity levels.
- When activated, the dehumidification function starts and runs until the humidity level begins to decrease + a set added time. After that, the unit returns to normal operation.

Necessary parameters can be adjusted using the Flexit GO app.



Nordic S - Unit for installation on the wall, floor or ceiling

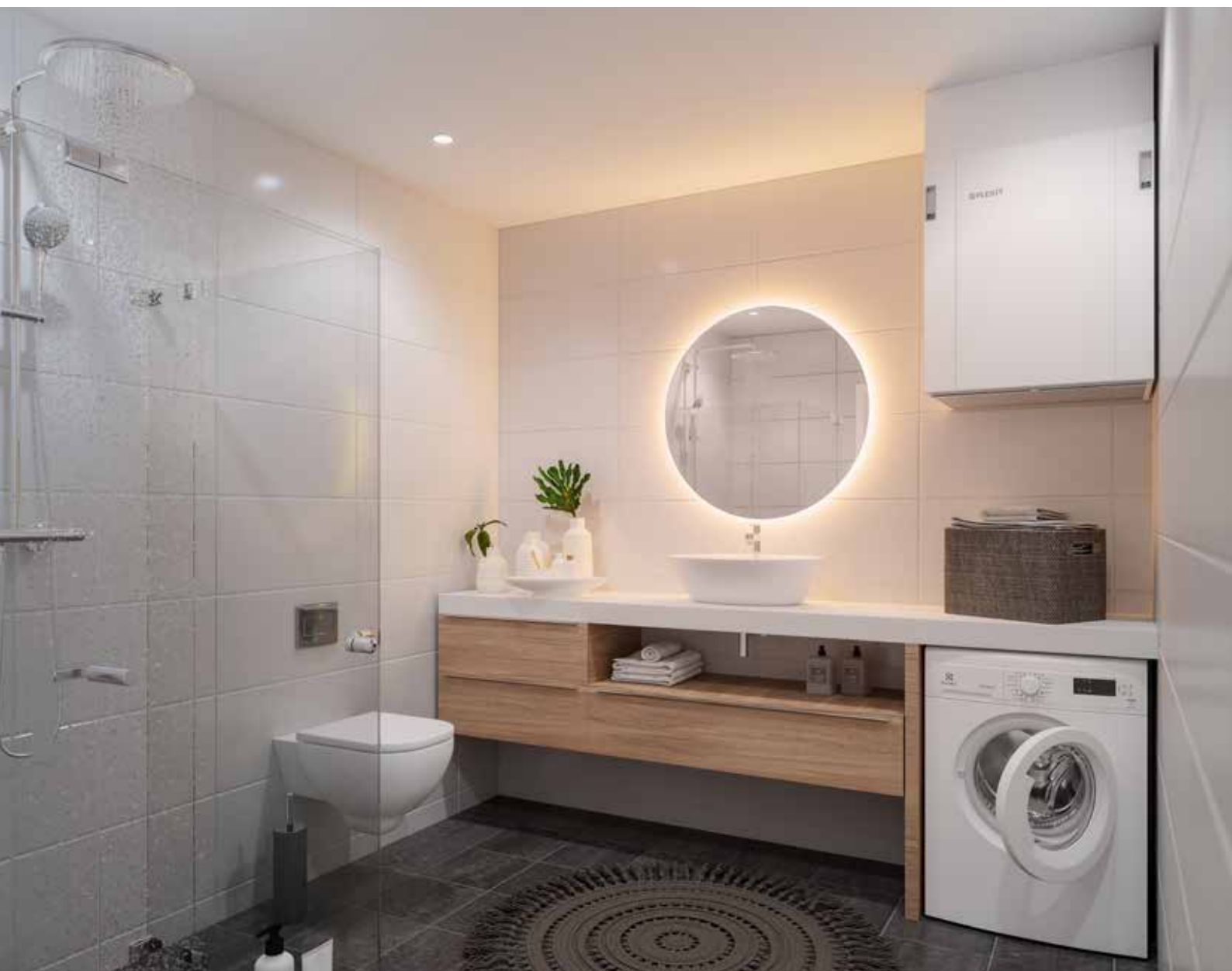

Easy to set up

The CL series consists of units for attic installation in cold areas, but can also be installed in suspended ceilings. The unit is small and flexible, with low height and low weight. This makes it easy to position and install, as it can be lifted through an attic staircase. This also means that the unit is ideal as a replacement for older air handling units.

A Nordic CL unit can also be fitted flush with the ceiling.

The air handling unit can also be placed on a wall, or standing or lying on the floor, e.g. in a utility room.

CL models are available as either right- or left-hand models, which simplifies duct routing and means that the ventilation system can quickly and easily be mirrored in two apartments. With configurable doors, it is also possible to choose in which direction the door opens.

Nordic KS3 can be placed in the kitchen above cooker. The unit's depth is only 318 mm and height 700 mm, including the rangehood. Thanks to its compact design, the unit can be installed between standard wall cabinets and hidden, either with a cabinet door from the kitchen supplier or with designfront panels from Flexit. Optional rangehoods in different colors are available for the unit.

Discreet design adapted to your kitchen decor with the Slimline rangehood

Slimline rangehood with very good odour extraction for connection to Nordic KS3. Discreet design with grey frontlist as standard. The rangehood's functions are easily controlled with buttons. LED lighting with dimmer function. Grease filter in metal that can be washed in the dishwasher. Electronic sliding damper in metal. Possibility to adjust the air flow for basic air. The rangehood is prepared for easy installation and with a quick connector for electrical connection to the unit. Available with both right and left duct connection.

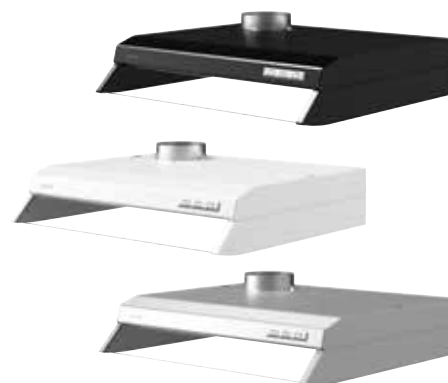
Frontpanel KS3 Slimline

Discreet design adapted to your kitchen decor with the Facet rangehood

The Facet rangehood is intended for Nordic KS3. The rangehood has very good odour extraction. Equipped with a metal grease filter that can be washed in the dishwasher. Electronic sliding damper in metal. Possibility to adjust the air flow for basic air. Electronic panel and good LED lighting with a very long service life. Supplied with cable for connection to Nordic K3. The rangehood is available with right and left duct connection and is easy to install and maintain.



Frontpanel KS3 Facet

Front panel in steel for Nordic KS3 in a discreet design. Fits Nordic KS3 together with the Facet rangehood. Gives the opportunity to match other kitchen furnishings. Available in black, white or stainless steel.



Duct cover KS3 close or open side

Duct cover in steel with telescopic solution to hide ducts between unit and roof. Available in two different variants, close or open side, depending on the duct layout. Gives the opportunity to match other kitchen furnishings. Available in black, white or stainless steel. Can be adjusted between 300–540 mm height.

Flexit Nordic KS3 can also be installed as cabinet unit in e.g. hallway or laundry room and can be hidden behind a sliding wall or with a door as part of the interior.

Even the wall-mounted Nordic KS3 can be supplemented with a designfront and duct cover to match other furnishings. Designfront and duct cover are available in black, white or stainless steel.

By means of an app, Flexit GO allows you to access the air handling unit from a mobile phone or tablet. It is also possible to check on noise or maintenance reports, set the desired temperature, select the ventilation setting, and receive information about filter replacements, etc. Having everything in one place makes things easy for you, and you do not need other control panels.

No matter where you are, the air handling unit can be controlled with Flexit GO. This allows the greatest flexibility, since you always have your mobile phone accessible – at home or when you are out. Flexit GO allows remote monitoring and service from Flexit or other service providers. That means we can help you as effectively as possible.

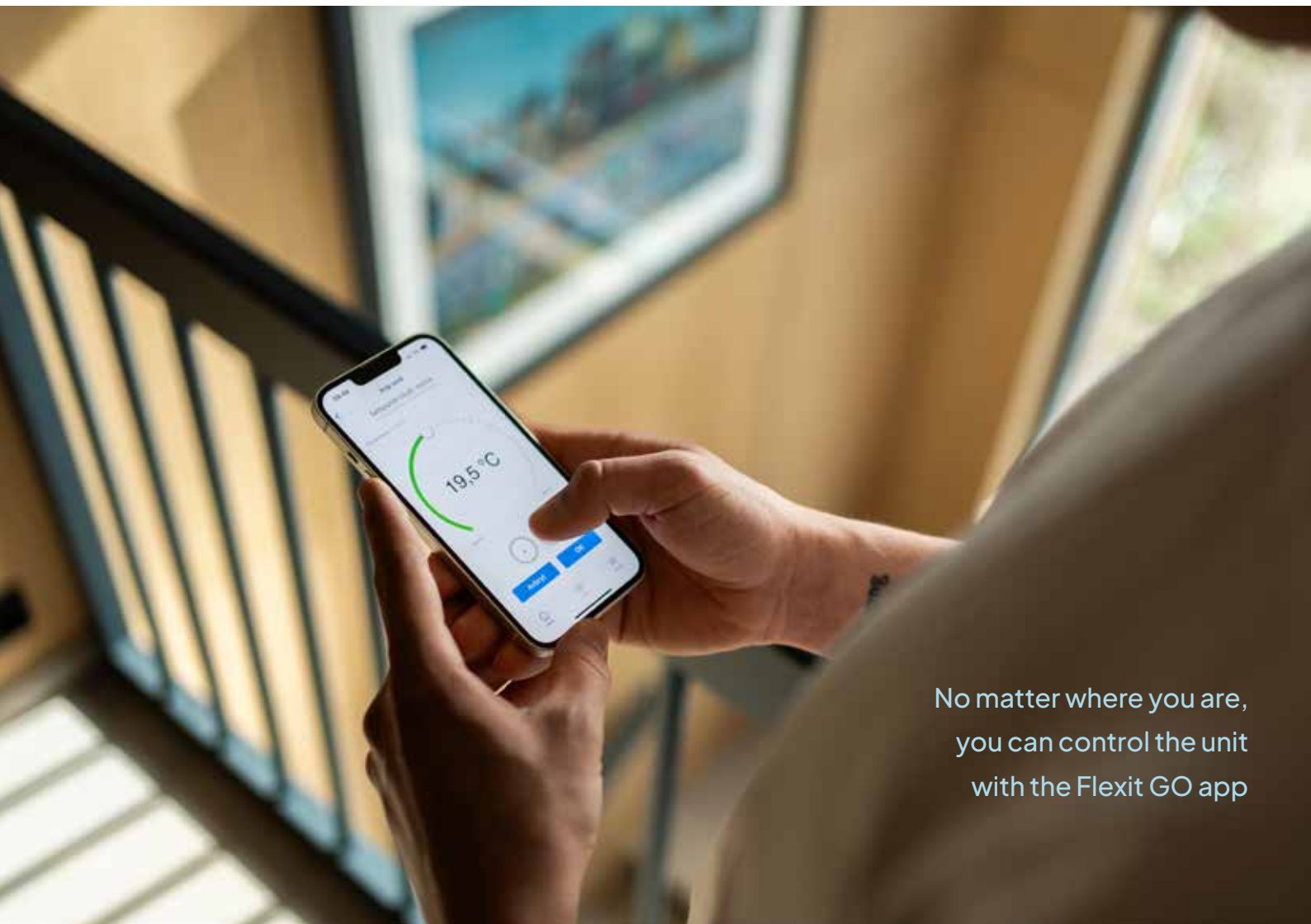

Ventilation controlled by requirements

You can easily adjust the ventilation according to requirements in your home, e.g. with functions to remove humidity, pressure sensor for extra supply air to rangehood, fireplace mode etc. Detectors for monitoring CO2, humidity or movement sends signals to the air handling unit, which then adjusts the ventilation as required. All accessories can also be controlled using the NordicPanel or the Flexit GO app. Read more about all accessories at flexit.com

Clean air in the kitchen is important for the air quality all through the house. For best results, therefore, the ventilation in the kitchen should be regarded as part of the total ventilation solution. Food smells should preferably not be spread to other rooms. Flexit supplies quality extractor hoods for different kitchen arrangements. They all have high capacity and operate reliably.



Let the central vacuum cleaner work with the ventilation system for an optimal indoor climate. Cleaning is simple and efficient with Flexit central vacuum cleaners. In addition, they remove the harmful micro dust, which can be dangerous to breathe in. It is all collected in a centrally placed vacuum cleaner, which is emptied several times a year. Depending on its position, you can vacuum clean almost without noise. Easy installation in new or existing housing.



Changing the filter is investing in a healthy indoor climate

Filters clean indoor air by removing harmful dust such as pollen, bacteria and other organic and inorganic materials. There are two filters in the air handling unit, a supply air filter and an exhaust air filter. A filter has a limited lifetime and it is therefore important to replace it when it is dirty. Clogged filters can reduce heat recovery in the unit and cause moisture damage. With Flexit original filters, the air handling unit will work in the best possible way and ensure hygienic and efficient operation.
